	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• thoracic cavity                             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ <i>properly bracketed from top of ribs to diaphragm (1 mark)</i></li> </ul> </li> <li>• abdominal cavity                             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ <i>properly bracketed from diaphragm to bottom of cavity (1 mark)</i></li> </ul> </li> <li>• rib cage (<i>clean cross section of bones</i>)</li> <li>• intercostal muscles (<i>indicate region between rib bones</i>)</li> <li>• urinary bladder</li> <li>• umbilical arteries (<i>indicate both</i>)</li> <li>• umbilical vein (<i>indicate cut piece near umbilical arteries</i>)</li> <li>• umbilical cord (<i>external structure</i>)</li> </ul>	/10	/11

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• liver</li> <li>• stomach (<i>liver may have to be raised with T-pin or probe to see</i>)</li> <li>• spleen (<i>if not clear, try to lay it to side</i>)</li> <li>• small intestine</li> <li>• large intestine (<i>if hard to see, move some small intestine</i>)</li> </ul>	/5	/6
